- Fair Queen Candidate is required to sign separate Fair Queen Scholarship Program forms.
- 2011 Fair Queen will receive a \$500 scholarship to the college of her choice.
- 2011 Fair Queen will be required to have sponsor's name listed on all parade signs.

**2011 Phelps County Fair Pageant
GUIDELINES**

1. Contestant will enter appropriate division, according to their age at time of pageant.
2. Judging will be based on - Stage Appearance, Public Speaking, Interview, Talent (if applicable).
3. Contestant understands that by their participation, they agree that any and all pictures will be used to promote the Phelps County Fair. This includes web and print ads.
4. Orientation for Little Fair, Jr. Fair, Fair Princess, and Fair Queen will be at 5:30 PM at the Grove **June 20, 2011**. This starts your first practice and you may turn form in or sign up that night. Contestant **must attend 7 out of 9 practices and the last two practices are MANDATORY.**
5. Forms must be submitted by **June 20, 2011** for Queen, Princess, Jr. Princess, and Little Princess.
6. Each pageant competition will immediately follow each other beginning with Queen division. Contestant agrees to abide by all rules/guidelines of the PCF pageant that are in affect now or as announced later. Contestant agrees the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely at the discretion of the PCF and the **decision of the judges will be final.**
 - a. Contestant shall be a citizen of the United States.
 - b. Contestant shall have residency of the County of Phelps, State of Missouri six months prior to the pageant.
 - c. Contestant shall be single with no children.
7. Official form filled out completely, signed acknowledging guidelines are understood and will abide.
8. The PCF winner will automatically relinquish her title if she enters into a marriage contract, if she chooses to cohabit with a male in lieu of marriage, or becomes pregnant.
9. Conduct deemed to be improper and/or detrimental to the Directors, Board, or the PCF pageants, will be reason for disqualification and dismissal by the Directors and/or Board.
10. Contestants may not have tattoos or body piercing exposed during practices or competition. Smoking is prohibited at all times. Should you be selected as winner - this guideline also applies.
11. If pageant winner fails to complete her term, the title will be passed to the runners-up in the order of their rank, beginning with 1st runner-up, if time is allotted for new title holder.
12. **Any contestant, family member(s), or friend(s) of contestant observed bashing other contestants, the contestant will be immediately disqualified without warning. This is strictly enforced.**
13. Dress code will be announced at first practice.
14. I understand that my duties will be designated by the Fair Queen, the Board, or the Pageant Directors. Winner agrees to work at the 2011 Phelps County Fair during the duration of the fair beginning at 8 AM – 11 PM.
15. **NO CONTESTANT MAY ENTER ANY DIVISION IF HOLDING A CURRENT TITLE OF ANY KIND SUCH AS CURRENT PCF, HOLIDAY, SWEETHEART, MISSOURI OUTDOORS, SHOW ME STATE, ROUTE 66 OR SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES. This also includes Preliminary, State, Internet, Magazine, and alike. If you are in question if you qualify or not, please contact Tina Goolsby at 573.308.7531.**
16. I understand that my duties will include presenting ribbons, trophies, and other duties including activity that will be held at the fairgrounds during the year - Demo Derby, Mud Run, Livestock, Fundraisers, clean-up, and etc. - as designated by the Fair Board or Pageant Directors. You are also required to assist with the PCF Holiday Pageant.
17. Fair Queen contestant understands that sponsor fee must be paid in full by **June 27, 2011.**

Candidate and Sponsor Requirements

All Fair Queen Candidates will receive a ribbon sash with sponsor's name printed at no cost.

Fair Queen Candidate's Responsibilities:

- Fair Queen Candidate is required to obtain a \$125 business sponsor. To be paid by June 27, 2011. Check is payable to Phelps County Fair.
- Fair Queen Candidate is required to participate in fair related events prior to fair with sponsor sash.
Example: Fundraisers and Take a Stand Against Child Abuse
- Fair Queen Candidate is required to wear sponsor sash during the duration of the fair.
- Fair Queen Candidate is required to wear sponsor sash during interview, group dance, and on stage introduction. Candidate is not required to wear sponsor sash during personal talent or formal wear.
- Fair Queen Candidate is required to mention sponsor in on stage speech.
- Fair Queen Candidate will receive one free season pass for current fair.
- Fair Queen Candidate is required to sign all Fair Queen Scholarship Program forms.
- 2011 Fair Queen will receive a \$500 scholarship payable to college or university of her choice with acceptance letter and scholarship request form.
- 2011 Fair Queen will be required to have sponsor's name listed on all parade signs.

Sponsor will receive:

- Advertising on large banner posted at the Grove outdoor stage during the Wednesday and Saturday pageant.
- Sponsor's name will be announced throughout both pageants.
- Sponsored Fair Queen Candidate will mention sponsor during onstage speech and introduction.
- Sponsored Fair Queen Candidate will be required to wear a sponsor sash during personal interview, group dance, on stage introduction, all four days of the fair, and any events prior to the fair.
- Sponsor's name will be listed in fair book on pageant application page the following year.
- Sponsor will receive honorable mention on special thank you page and on the fair queen's page in the fair book the following year.
- Sponsor's name will be listed on all 2011 Fair Queen parade signs.

I fully understand my responsibilities as Fair Queen Candidate for obtaining a sponsor and requirements thereafter. I fully understand the sponsorship money paid is non-refundable by the Phelps County Fair. Should I withdraw from pageant at anytime, the business has the right to seek repayment from me.

Scholarship Rules & Guidelines**

I fully understand that in order to claim any scholarship money awarded by the Phelps County Fair board, I must do the following:

Request the scholarship in writing.

Deliver or mail the scholarship request to the Phelps County Fair Pageant Director.

The letter will contain the following information: legal name of the school I am attending; address of the school; routing and/or physical address of the registrar's office. My student ID number for the school listed in the scholarship request letter.

All requests should be mailed to:

Once the letter is received a check will be issued made payable to the school. This check will be mailed via US post, certified return receipt to the registrar's office listed in my scholarship request letter.

If I have no outstanding debt from any recognized institution of higher learning, in order to claim my scholarship money I must submit a paid receipt from the institution that I have graduated from or attended. I will also outline the mailing address that my scholarship check should be sent to. Once that official paid receipt from the registrar's office is received a check will be mailed via US post, certified return receipt to the address listed in my scholarship request letter.

I understand that reimbursement cannot be made. I further understand the time line I have to request the scholarship awarded is the time frame of my reign or within three years of crowning. Meaning, I have from the time I am crowned up to three years of crowning in order to request the scholarship money to be awarded. Should I fail to request my scholarship within this time frame; I will fail to receive any scholarship money.
