

# 2025 Phelps County Fair Livestock Rules

## **PCF General Livestock Rules**

1. Online registration will be available starting on April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All livestock must be registered by no later than Friday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025. Entries received after this date will incur a \$25 late fee/species registered. All exhibitors can begin registering by visiting [www.phelpscountyfair.com](http://www.phelpscountyfair.com).
2. All livestock are subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian.
3. Livestock may not arrive until 8:00 a.m. Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All livestock entries must be on the fairgrounds by Thursday of the fair by 12:00 p.m. **No digital breed registration papers will be accepted at check-in.**
4. **All breeding and market livestock will require valid health papers per the Missouri Department of Agriculture. The papers must be current (within 30 days) and must have each animal listed by an identification tag/tattoo approved by the Missouri Department of Agriculture. More information can be read at the following website: <https://agriculture.mo.gov/animals/rules.php>. These papers will be examined by a barn chairman prior to unloading at the fairgrounds. This will take place on Thursday, May 29 from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Animals can't be unloaded until health papers have been checked! Failure to follow this procedure, will result in immediate dismissal of livestock. Pen assignments will also be made by the barn chairman at this time. The barn chairman is the only individual authorized to make pen and stall assignments (i.e. by club, lottery, or other method as chosen by barn chairman), and will depend on the number of entries received.**
5. Each exhibitor will furnish their own feed and bedding.
6. **No portable power (i.e. generators, generator trailers, etc.) can be used within 100 feet of any livestock barn.**
7. Each exhibitor shall purchase a season pass in advance and exchange for a wristband.
8. All awarded ribbon colors will be determined by the judges.
9. Each exhibitor will be paid one premium per class. Premiums will be paid by the color of the ribbon awarded.
10. All cattle shall be halter broke.
11. Breeding livestock will be released at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday of the fair. All exhibitors must check-in with Species Superintendent before removing their animals from the fair. If exhibitors remove livestock on their own accord, all premiums will be forfeited.
12. **The exhibitor must obey all Livestock Rules, in addition to the International Association of Fairs and Expositions (IAFE) Show Ring Code of Ethics, <https://www.mostatefair.com/wp-content/uploads/animal-code-ethics.pdf> as adopted by the Missouri State Fair. Violation of these rules or ethics will result in forfeiture of premium money or disqualification from shows.**
13. Open shows are for exhibitors over 21 and for juniors ages 8 – 21 who earn a blue ribbon in the junior show (with competition) or who are not members of 4-H or FFA. For an animal exhibited by a junior exhibitor to advance to the open show, it must receive a blue ribbon.
14. Youth exhibitors who are members of a 4-H or FFA chapter in Phelps County must participate in one of the two fairground clean-up days for the Phelps County Fair and the Phelps Co. Youth Livestock Showcase and Sale (PCYLS&S) on either Saturday, May 17, 2025 or Saturday, July 26, 2025 starting at 8:00 a.m. each day.
15. Livestock pens and stalls **MUST BE** kept clean and tidy throughout the duration of the fair. If Species Superintendent determines livestock pens and stalls are not clean and tidy, premium(s) may be withheld.
16. Tie out space will be provided for **cattle** and tie out time is 9:00 p.m. All livestock must return to the barn by no later than 7:00 a.m. daily.
17. All animals must have been owned and registered in the name of the exhibitor at least 30 days before day of show.
18. In order for animals to show in the purebred classes they must be registered, with the exceptions of poultry and rabbits.
19. Exhibitors will not be allowed to have alcoholic beverages at any time. Failure to comply with this rule and you will be asked to remove livestock and yourself from the premises. All entry fees and premiums will then be forfeited.
20. Recreational vehicle parking is on a first come first served basis following the paperwork outlined on the fair website.
21. Only animals entered to show will be allowed in the barns.
22. All hogs must be washed in the wash rack.
23. Cattle ribbon premiums (Blue - \$20, Red - \$15, White - \$10)
24. Swine, sheep, goat premiums (Blue - \$12, Red - \$9, White - \$7)

25. Poultry and rabbit premiums (Blue - \$3, Red - \$2, White - \$1)
26. Animals entered and shown by junior exhibitors must be shown by the junior exhibitor. In the event an exhibitor has multiple animals in a class, another junior exhibitor registered at the PCF must show the animal. No adults will be permitted to show animals in a junior.
27. Little Tikes Exhibition Classes: Beef & Dairy, Sheep, Pigs, Goats, Poultry, and Rabbits. These classes will be open to children less than 8 as of January 1 of the current fair year. All participants will receive a participation ribbon only. A parent or guardian of the exhibitor will be asked to sign a release of liability waiver during registration. A parent or guardian **must** accompany the exhibitor and animal in showing. This event will only be available at the PCF (May Fair).
28. Showmanship Classes will be held for the following age groups: Junior (8-10); Intermediate (11-15); Senior (16-21).
29. Old-Timers Exhibition Class - \$10 nomination fee to enter and \$20 fee to decline nomination. All proceeds will benefit the Scholarship Fund.
30. All rabbit and poultry exhibitors must provide food and water cups which must be secured to the provided cages.
31. All rabbit and poultry exhibitors can only enter one rabbit or bird per breed per class.
32. All rabbit entries must be identified by a permanent tattoo in the left ear.
33. All poultry must have a pullorum test performed Thursday, May 29, 2025.
