***Description of Phelps County Fair ATV Rodeo Events**

All Wheels Drag Race: Racing as fast as possible from Start to Finish.

Bow Tie: The time is started and will end when the contestant has completed the Bow Tie pattern and returned to the starting position.

Barrel Race: The contestant must start at a given point. The flag man will signal contestant to begin and the contestant will move through the barrels in a uniform pattern. If the contestant breaks the pattern, they will be disqualified. A ten second penalty will occur for every barrel that is tipped over.

Pole Race: The contestant must start at a given point. The flag man will signal a contestant to begin. The ATV rider will move through the poles in a uniform pattern. If the contestant breaks the pattern, they will be disqualified. A 10 second penalty will occur for every pole that is tipped over. Time will end when each rider has completed the pattern and returned to the designated spot.

JUDGING:

1. A panel of judges (any combination of the Track Supervisor, official or flagman) will review all scenarios not covered by the listed rules.
2. All decisions made solely by the Track Supervisor will be the final.
(Any inquiry must be addressed in writing)

RIDERS CONDUCT:

1. All riders shall conduct themselves in a respectful manner.
2. **All manufacturing recommendations must be enforced.** Riders must be in control of their vehicle(s) during operation. If a rider is reckless or lacks control, officials may disqualify each participant.

All Regulations are listed for Safety Purposes

ENTRIES: Enter as many vehicles in as many classes as you want, however, (Time limits and total number of riders are determined by the Track Supervisor).

RESTRICTIONS DO APPLY!

***(The Drivers meeting will include the following Rules and Regulations)**

1. No person under the age of (5) will be allowed to compete.
2. D.O.T. approved helmet and eye protection is required.
3. Boots OR shoes – (no sandals or flip flops), gloves, shirts (no tank tops), and pants are required – (no shorts for ATV riders).
4. Speed limit is 5-10 mph when not participating in an individual event in the pits or in route to a specific event or inspection.
5. No alcohol or drugs of any kind are allowed in the pit area.
6. Helmets must be worn at all times when riding any ATV or UTV.
7. Any person who appears to be chemically impaired will not be allowed to compete. Their registration fee will be forfeited.
8. Non-conformance to the principals of this event will result in immediate disqualification of the participant; subsequent expulsion from the fairgrounds and all fees will be forfeited.
9. Riding is allowed ONLY between pits and each specified event.
10. Speeding in the pit area or during non-event operation of any motor vehicle, ATV or UTV must be kept low and not to exceed 10 MPH. NO stunt riding (i.e. wheelies) will be allowed. Riders WILL be warned or disqualified for inappropriate riding.
11. ABSOLUTELY NO PIT RIDING. IF CAUGHT YOU MAY BE DISQUALIFIED WITHOUT WARNING AND ASKED TO LEAVE THE EVENT AND POSSIBLY THE FAIRGROUNDS.

OFFICIAL RACETRACK RULES

1. All riders **MUST** attend the Rider's meeting before the races can begin.
2. We reserve the right to rework the course at any time during the event.
3. When registering for events, the individual must select their class and age group. The judges reserve the right and may place participants in a class they feel is best for fair competition.
4. Any tire size will be allowed, chains or spikes will not.
5. Helmet & goggles must be strapped on before starting.
6. Operator must stay on machine during a run, dismounting from the machine terminates the run. Unless otherwise instructed by the official.
7. No burnouts will be allowed in the pits or between the staging area.
8. Stock or modified vehicles will be allowed.
9. After completing a run, riders will immediately head to the pit area.
10. Once a rider enters the staging lanes, there will be no exiting.
11. Class jumping will be allowed as long as you are undersized for the class.
12. The Track Supervisor and Flagmen control each run for safety purposes.
13. Flagmen start each event and will raise a hand to start your turn, and time.
14. Flagmen at the finish will drop his hand to end your turn, and time.
15. Timer starts and stops with the flags, unless digital timing is used.
16. Riders must obey the all flag officials or may be subject to disqualification.
17. In case of a breakdown, each rider is responsible for hooking the towrope to his/her own vehicle; any and all damages incurred while competing or when being pulled are the sole responsibility of the rider and no one else.
18. Knocking over a barrel or cone, or any course infraction, will result in a time penalty for each violation, as determined by the Track Supervisor.
19. We reserve the right to combine competition classes, in the event of a lack of entries per class to keep winning fair. The number of participants in each class is at the discretion of the Track Supervisor and/or judges.
20. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Any display of profanity or unacceptable behavior, may result in disqualification. A participant or spectator may be escorted off the fairgrounds and will forfeit any fees paid.
21. All participants agree to compete in a fair manner and will follow all rules.
